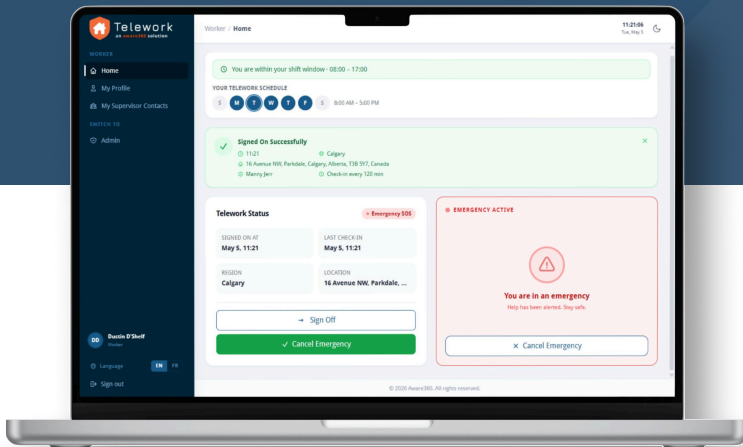

A simple safety process for remote and hybrid workers

The day starts safely, or it doesn't

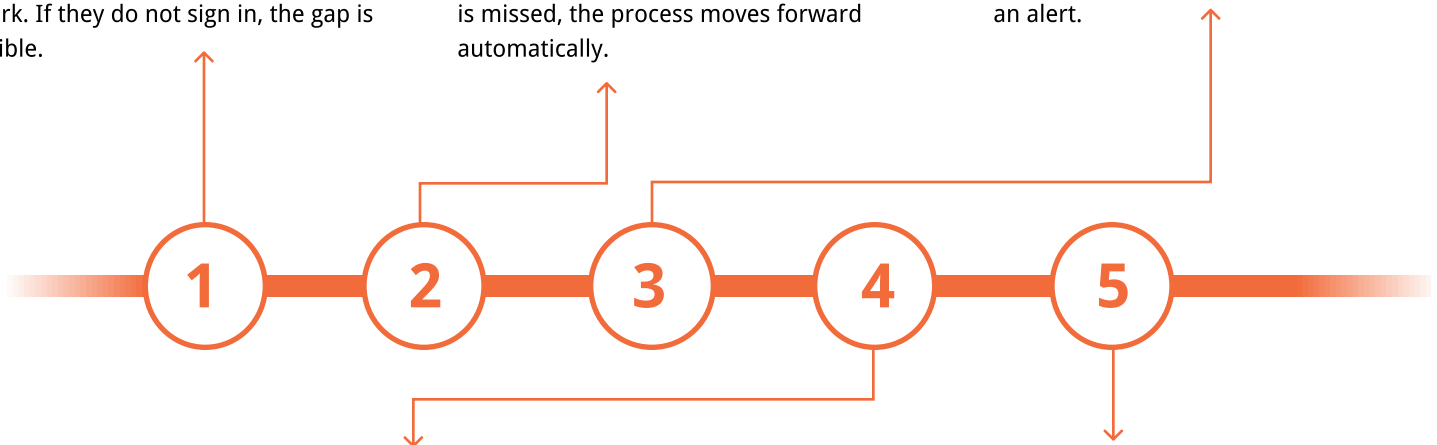
The employee signs in at the start of the day to confirm they are safe and beginning work. If they do not sign in, the gap is visible.

Check-ins are completed, or one is missed

Scheduled safety check-ins help confirm the employee is okay throughout the day. If one is missed, the process moves forward automatically.

Work continues, or an alert is triggered

On a normal day, there is no disruption. If something may be wrong, Telework creates an alert.



The employee responds, or escalation begins
The employee can confirm they are safe or trigger SOS if they need help. If they do not respond, the alert follows the escalation plan in SafetyAware.

The day is closed, with everything documented
Whether it was a routine day or a response event, check-ins, alerts, escalations, and actions taken are recorded to support duty of care.
